Conditions for the team challenge are as follows:

Teams may be comprised of three or four horse/ rider combinations.

Each team must be comprised of one horse/rider combination from each of the CCI divisions.
(1*,2* and 3*)

A rider may compete on more than one team however a horse may only compete on one team.

A rider may only compete one horse per team.

It is encouraged that a team is comprised of riders of the same nationality.

Teams may be sponsored.

Scoring and final classification will be in accordance with FEI Rules for Eventing.

The Team entry must be made on the Greenbrier Farm Cup Entry form and submitted to the Secretary by 5:00pm Thursday June 11th. (ie after the First Horse Inspection) . The entry will list those competitors who comprise a team but it will not determine the order of go. The Team entry must be accompanied by a fee of \$100.00CA.
